California Here I come!

Mike was invited to LA in early November, where he was interviewed on a Christian TV show, Lifestyles Magazine. This program airs on Sky Angel and TBN. The taping was for a one hour show where he had the opportunity to share his testimony and was interviewed regarding Cops for Christ. They plan to air the show in January and he was informed that the program will reach many hundreds of thousands of people.

While he was in California he was also invited to share at two Bible Studies and also at a Vineyard church during two services where 35 people were saved. He also had positive response to his messages via e-mail etc. and that is always good news.



What's happening on the home front?

Mike has been sharing as the main speaker at a prison in Brooksville, FL For the past year. During that time approximately 98 people have been saved so far. He spoke last night 12/11 and eight women got saved. (This is part of the 98 total).

In addition to this he shares at a weekly Bible Study at our home church, currently he is teaching on the Book of Acts. He has also been teaching on Daniel.

Ann has been volunteering at our local church doing some administration...one of her responsibilities have been overseeing the Children's Ministry and doing the bookkeeping and the Administration for our daycare and preschool. We minister mostly to children of very low income families and we have also been providing food baskets to them on a regular basis. Our local church feeds the hungry once a week a hot meal (usually about 100 people) and give out about 60 food baskets to the needy.



Our local church also puts on a Christmas Comedy dinner theater each year. This is a tremendous outreach to the community and is offered free of charge. We always pick a play with a strong Christian message. This year, we performed, "Christmas comes to Detroit Louie." Ann acted as the director and also the make-up person for the entire cast. It was awesome. Very exhausting 5 days, but very rewarding.

What are the plans for the New Year?

Our plans are to go to Nigeria, Africa, as well as Ireland, England, N. Ireland and Guyana. If it is possible we would also like to set up a trip to W. Canada, Lord willing.
