

## **Trip To The Philippines**

### **February 2004**

On Sunday, 2/8, we spoke at the Union Church of Manila to the youth group. Mike shared his testimony and 12 teens accepted Christ. In the afternoon we were invited to Camp Crame chapel. This is the headquarters for all the Police of the Philippines. Terry, Dave and Mike shared with the Police and their wives. Afterwards, a Colonel took us all out to eat at an Italian restaurant.

On Monday, 2/9, we had a welcome at Camp Crame with many of the police that are helping us in the meetings. It was fruitful and we had good sharing. In the afternoon one Pastor that is a Chaplain took us to his radio show and all of us shared for one hour. It was really nice and we had some calls that came in asking questions.

On Tuesday, 2/10 Mike and brothers shared at a Division at Camp Crame and 5 police accepted Christ. Then we went to the women's prison and had a 1½ hour meeting and about 95 women accepted Christ.

Wednesday, 2/11: Today we shared at a bible study at Camp Aquinaldo, which is the headquarters for the Army. We had about 20 present and they accepted Christ. Immediately after this, we went to another dept where we shared to a smaller group, but many were blessed.

Pray for Mike and his team through the balance of the known schedule:

Thursday, 2/12, tomorrow, we have two meetings scheduled at Camp Crame and a night meeting at Camp Aquinaldo. In the early morning we are visiting the Help International, baby home and midwifery work.

Friday, 2/13, We leave for the airport at 3AM for Iloilo where we leave immediately for Antique, about 4 hours by bus for a night rally there.

Saturday, 2/14: Leave Antique early Saturday to go back to Guimbal where the team will speak at an island youth conference--all day and evening.

Sunday, 2/15, we are scheduled to speak in the AM and PM at two churches.

Monday, 2/16, there is a Police/Firemen's gathering for lunch in Iloilo City. Then we are scheduled to leave that night for Palawan by ship. It's a two nights one day trip.

Tuesday, 2/17 in transit by ship to Palawan Island.

Wednesday, 2/18 through Monday, 2/23. Palawan, Thanks for your prayers for all the meetings on Palawan Island

Tuesday, 2/24 The Police Academy meeting in Laguna on the 24th

Wednesday, 2/25 All day at the baby and midwifery home.

Thursday, 2/26: At Camp Crame for an afternoon symposium on transformation. All police districts were required to send at least 25 Police Officers to this. That meeting went from 1:30 to 5 PM. Then the leaders of the fellowship of Police took us out for dinner.

This was Mike's last day we had a meeting with General Laurilla and his staff. He is head of the government moral recovery program nationwide. Thanks for your prayers for many souls to be saved, sick to be healed and many to experience the reality of a spirit filled life! God Bless.
